Exhibit is limited to appx 30 pieces. Included pieces will be juried by a peer panel from the submissions. Evaluations will be based on: Composition, Impact, Creativity, Technical Execution and Consistency with the Theme.

The gallery is in a performing arts center open to all ages. Images submitted should be appropriate for this environment.

NJPF Members\* only

##### Entry Procedure:

Submit artwork by July 24, 2026 at:

Applicants may submit up to 4 pieces not previously shown at this location. Entries as a jpeg: 72dpi, Maximum 1280 pixels on each side. The submission instructions require image title, frame size, and price for each piece entered.

##### Fees:

##### Specifications:

All pieces must be framed and matted in accordance with NJPF Standards: black frame, white mat, securely wired to hang on a Walker System. Canvas wraps, metal prints or other flush mounted work with black float frames are acceptable. No clip frames. See website for framing details. Use of plexi for safety on large pieces is recommended. Sizes up to 32" wide including the frame may be submitted. All pieces MUST be labeled on the back with complete contact info. Removeable label on front with title
